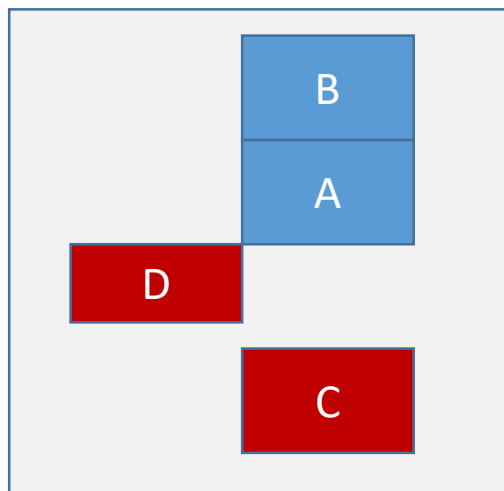
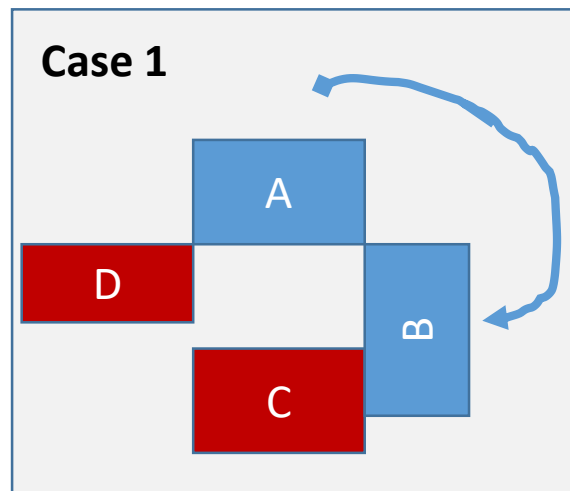


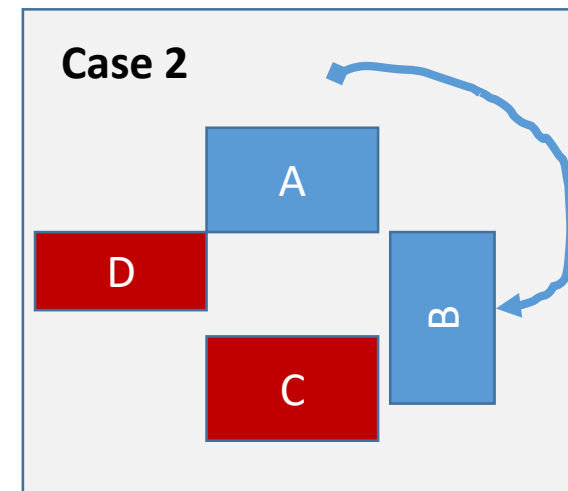
Starting Blue Position



Blue Move to Partial Flank Contact



Blue Move to Flank but no touch



Blue has only 1 MP. He wishes to use Case 1 to insure if C attacks the following activation, B will be in flank contact with C.

In Case 1, B has not moved into “flank contact” (only partial flank contact, as allowed by 54.4).

Red argues, that while this conforms to 54.4, the move into partial blue front to red side contact gives the Blue an unintended advantage.

Red posits that Case 2 or Case 3 are more appropriate where the positioning or contact would not lead to a flank contact on a future C forward movement.
